### **General**

- **No rough play or abusive language is permitted. Abuse of officials, referees, and other staff will not be tolerated. Any behavior deemed unacceptable by staff/refs will result in suspension and/or ejection from a game or the league. Anyone who throws a punch (under any circumstances) will be kicked out of the league without refund, as well as being banned from the Fieldhouse for life.**
- 7-week regular season and 2 weeks of playoffs (single elimination).
- 6 on 6 with no designated goalie.

### **Equipment**

- Shin Guards are required for play in this league.
- All teams must wear unifying colors.
- Athletic shoes only, no cleats.

### **Time**

- Two twenty-five minute halves with a running clock.
- During the regular season, tie games stand. In the playoffs, games that end in a tie will go into a 5-minute sudden death overtime. For this overtime period, each team will field 6 players. The first team to score a goal wins. If no goal is scored in the overtime then it will result in a shootout.

### **Kickoffs**

- Kickoffs are taken from midfield and can be kicked backwards. A player other than the one who takes the kickoff (from either team) must touch the ball before the kicker can touch it a second time. A violation of this rule will result in a re-kick. Kickoffs are direct kicks and a goal can be scored directly from a kickoff.

### **Substitutions**

- Teams can substitute "on the fly" at any point during the game, no limit.

### **Foul/Penalty**

- Upon a called foul/penalty the referee will award a direct free kick to be played by the offended team.
  - Pushing, kicking, tripping, holding, or interfering with opponent
  - Charging or rough play
  - Dangerous play or high kick
  - Checking along the wall
  - Yellow card:
    - First offence results in a 2-minute penalty
    - Second yellow card/red card received then the player must leave the game and is suspended from the next game, no substitution is allowed until the opposing team scores a goal or after 5 minutes

### **Penalty Kick**

- A penalty kick will be taken at the penalty mark with only the kicker and the opposing goalie on line of the goal. All other players must stand behind the shooter and can't enter the shooting area until the ball has crossed the goal line.
